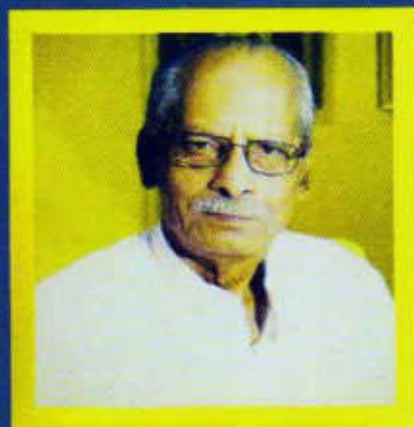

ADMISSION

- Admission through entrance test from Class I to VIII & XI. A Student is required to secure at least 70% marks in the X Board examination in science subjects in case he/she wants admission to class XI.
- Countersigned T.C. is required in case of admission is out of state.
- The candidate should have been a student of English Medium School run on the CBSE pattern & affiliated to CBSE or ICSE.
- Two Passport size photographs of the candidate & two photographs of his/her guardian should be pasted on the specified space. Only one local guardian other than the Parents is allowed to be listed in admission form & visitors' list.
- Submission of all documents and payment of all dues at the time of admission.
- Re-admission is compulsory for the candidate promoted to the upper classes & for them who are detained in the same class.
- Application form & prospectus can be obtained from the school office on payment of ₹ 250/- in person & ₹ 300/- by post.
- Admission or issue of T.C. is not allowed in the middle of the session particularly after 20th April.

N.B All dues of student must be cleared before each examination. (it's mandatory)

RULES & REGULATIONS

FOR SCHOOL



- ▶ All the students need to report in the school regularly & punctually with complete uniform, book copies & study material. They have to maintain discipline everywhere as it is key to their success.
- ▶ Prayer for leave in the form of application should reach Principal only through the respective class teacher of a student.
- ▶ No student is allowed to be absent himself/herself from the class without obtaining prior permission of leave.
- ▶ Books (Other than those prescribed by the teachers) and magazines are not allowed into the classroom without the permission of teachers.
- ▶ No groupism should be created in the school. No function should be organized without the approval of the Principal.
- ▶ Parents are welcome to contact the Principal about the progress of their child.
- ▶ Parents/Guardians are not allowed to come to school at their own sweet will and meet the Principal or teachers and disturb the school discipline.
- ▶ Extra coaching in vacations for slow learners or completion of course etc. is the sole discretion of staff council's decision. It will be noticed prior to the concerned vacation when need for such classes are felt.
- ▶ Parents can check the copies of exams, of their wards in the Parents' meeting following 1st exam excluding class IX & X.
- ▶ Doubt clearance, receipt of certificate, payment of any kind etc. is to be communicated within school hour i.e. 8 a.m. to 12 noon only.
- ▶ Re-admission to the next class is to be done within 15th April or else the child can't appear in periodic tests, half yearly and annual exam.
- ▶ All need to report on the re-opening class after all vacations. So do all need to leave the school on the last working day of all vacations.
- ▶ Only Parents and Local Guardian can visit the child during visiting hour but others are not allowed if authorisation is not there.

RULES & REGULATIONS

TC

- ▶ T.C. is not allowed to be issued in the middle of the session.
- ▶ Application for T.C. should be submitted at least 7 days before the required date of issue with the clearance of the dues till the current month.
- ▶ Clearance Certificate (Office, Store, Library, Sports, Laboratory, Computer) is required before issue of T.C. In case of loss of any material the cost of the material besides certain amount of fine is imposed which needs to be deposited.



WITHDRAWAL

- ▶ Generally withdrawals are remitted at the end of the session if such withdrawal is warranted for satisfactory reasons.
- ▶ Absence for more than 3 months immediately after summer vacation renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off from the rolls.
- ▶ The following categories of Pupils may be required to be withdrawn from the school.
 - ▶ Those who do not achieve the satisfactory progress.
 - ▶ Those whose fees are in arrears.
 - ▶ Those whose behaviour in the opinion of the Principal is harmful to the interest of the school.
- ▶ The transfer certificate can be issued only after all the fees and dues of the school are paid and verified and after being cleared from different sections.
- ▶ If a student is withdrawn for any length of time and the parents wish him/her to be readmitted, admission fees will be charged again.

EXAMINATION

As per CBSE'S Comprehensive examination pattern w.e.f. 2017-2018 our examination schedule is as follows:

Periodic Assessment-I	August
Half Yearly	October
Periodic Assessment-II	January
Annual Exam	March

Academic session, commences w.e.f. 1st. April to 31st March of the following year.

- ▶ Minimum attendance necessary to appear examination is 75%.
- ▶ Each child has to score at least 'D' grade in every subject to get promotion to the next higher class. (Std VI - IX).
- ▶ Relaxation in attendance on medical ground is considered only if it is 60%.
- ▶ As per the CBSE affiliation pre-requisites all students from class VIII & IX need to pass individually in all subjects. In case of failure they will be given chance for retest within 7 days of the publication of result. If they do not qualify then under no circumstance they will be allowed promotion even if aggregate has pass mark.
- ▶ Time for Class X & XII is extremely valuable. So they will not be involved in any other activities of Vidyalaya except study. They cannot leave for elsewhere during 1st December to 31st March.
- ▶ Project & activities, Debates, Seminar, report, speech, conversation are part of the examination system for internal evaluation.
- ▶ A child is not entitled for rank if he/she remains absent in any of the Examination for what soever reasons upto Senior Secondary students.
- ▶ Engg. & Medical coaching is provided to senior students by expert hands.
- ▶ Coaching classes are conducted for the Senior secondary Students during summer Vacations only.
- ▶ For Class Xth class Periodic Assesment-II On Decmeber and Periodic Assesment - III On January.

LIBRARY, STUDY MATERIALS & SYLLABUS



LIBRARY

The library in the school is well equipped to serve students with a huge stock of books, magazines and journals.

- No book shall be taken out of the library without the permission of the librarian.
- A student/boarder can keep a book issued to him/her for a week. In case of missing or torn a fine of ₹ 5.00 per day will be charged for each book. The fine will be realized from him along with the school fee of the month.
- For use in reading room ordinarily one book or journal at a time may be issued to every student.
- If a book is lost or damaged the student has to pay double the cost of the book along with the fine accrued. If price of the lost book cannot be ascertained he/she should pay the amount fixed by the principal.
- Maximum 5 books to the teachers and two books to the students may be issued at a time.
- In case of retaining the book for more days, the book has to be reissued for a period of four weeks but not more than that. Books should be returned before all vacations.



STUDY MATERIALS

All text books and notes are purchased only from school book store. If anybody wants to take extra requirements over and above the stipulated set of materials provided to each student, he/she can draw the same from the book store by paying in the school office.

Total cost of books and copies is charged as per the printed price of the respective items.

PHYSICS LAB



GHVM, Puri is proud to have a sophisticated Physics Laboratory with the latest state-of-the-art facilities that equip the students to have hands on experience. The Flat-topped tables used as student workstations allow multiple arrangements and combinations for laboratory work and small-group activities.



The equipment ranges from the commonly found lens, magnet, beam balance, spring balance, glass prism to the advanced apparatus like voltmeter, ammeter and resistors and spectrometers to name a few. The laboratory is also equipped with an Interactive board and an LCD projector that allows the teachers to incorporate the latest technology in their lessons to arouse the interest and curiosity of the students.

CHEMISTRY LAB



The avant-garde Chemistry Laboratory provides a platform for students to nurture the budding scientist within them. The laboratory is furnished with latest hi-tech interactive smart boards for a virtual real life learning experience.



The Lab is provided with the state-of-the-art devices like- Fume hood, Distillation unit, Electronic weighing machine, Bunsen burners, beakers and flasks. Concealed gas line and the safety devices such as Firefighting equipment, First-Aid Kit etc. The acids and other reactive chemicals are stored in separate locked cupboards as a further precautionary measure. The students are provided with separate workstations with individual burners and plug points. The apparatus includes the common place strikers, mortar and pestle, clay triangles, watch glasses, crucibles, crucible tongs, chemical spoon, stirring rods, filter funnels and a variety of stoppers.

BIOLOGY LAB

GHVM vaunts an intricately designed Biology Laboratory planned to meet the demands of the advancement in science and technology. The marble worktops are heat resistant and storage cabinets are easily accessible. The laboratory apparatus ranges from simple slides, test-tube, petridishes to the composite microscopes of varying powers to observe samples and organisms closely. They are high-powered, extremely expensive, and sensitive pieces of equipments that can make even the smallest part of a single cell seem clear. All the microscopes with digital eyepieces and built in cameras are a great way to preview live colour digital images directly from microscope to the computer via a USB port.

Besides the aforesaid the laboratory also has charts, models and specimens meant for demonstrations. The interactive board connected to a computer system and projector makes the biology lessons more effective and interesting. The exhaust system efficiently sustains a comfortable environment in the room even while performing experiments requiring chemicals that let out fumes.



COMPUTER LAB

The school has two spacious computer labs. The entire campus is networked and INTRANET & INTERNET facilities are provided for various tasks pertaining to the daily routine.

Computer science is taught as an additional subject right from Class I to Class X. The students of these classes are taught various software modules on different networks and different Operating systems. Computer science is taught as an optional subject for classes XI & XII. The students of these classes are taught C++, SQL, Boolean Algebra, Python, Mongo DB and Networking Basics.

HOSTEL



The hostel provides accommodation taking into account the need of the students for a healthy living. There is house master to guide the activities of the students including three hours evening coaching class to support & strengthen the academic standard of the students.

- The boarders are warned that 98% attendance is required for promotion.
- The boarders should wash their own utensils themselves. (from IV to XII)
- Food or any other materials from outside the school are strictly prohibited.
- No one can go outside of the campus without the permission of the Principal. Lending or borrowing money and other articles are not permitted in the school.
- No one is allowed to keep any valuable and costly items, cash / mobile / electronic items etc. For any kind of missing or theft of anything the authority will not be responsible. Instead those items will be seized and not refundable. Also a heavy fine will be imposed on the errant student. (around Rs1000)
- There are three pairs of hostel uniforms are to be used in the hostel only. There are two pairs of sports uniforms to be used in games time & in morning PET. White canvas shoes are to be used during morning PET, games & drill time.
- Guardians are not allowed to meet their wards without the permission of the Superintendent.
- All sorts of communication are to be done through office.
- Extra leave for the student requested by the guardian is strictly prohibited. It may be decided only in the presence of Principal.
- All parents and guardians are requested to wait in the waiting room/guest room of the Vidyalaya to meet their wards.
- Parents are required to take & leave their children with them at the time of vacation or else they should give due authorisation to someone who would take or leave their children. All parents of class X & XII students ought to come on the last day of the Board Examination to take their children on the same day.
- Prayer of any kind through application should reach superintendent & principal only through the respective house masters of boarders.
- Evening prayer and morning prayer are compulsory for the boarders. If anyone is absent, he must get prior permission from PET.
- During school hour/study hours, no one is allowed to move to the STD booth.
- Before going to booth, one must get prior permission from the House master / teacher.
- There is no provision to entertain any visitor after 1'0 Clock. Visitors and vehicles are to leave the campus before 1'0 Clock.
- Celebrating festival/day and birthday individually by the students wearing new clothes is not allowed.
- Carrying food from mess to room is not allowed. Only sick meal is allowed with permission of house master/ Superintendent.

FEE STRUCTURE



- Students appearing for Board Examination should pay fees as prescribed by the Board.
- They need to clear all the annual dues before they fill in the form for Board Exam (X,XII). i.e. by last week of August.
- There will be onetime down payment ascertained by the Institution from time to time. In case of Senior Secondary classes at the time of admission & readmission.
- All dues, including school & Hostel fees must be cleared before each Examination (i.e. Periodics & Half yearly & Annual exam). There is no provision for retest due to late payment of dues.
- Parents and guardians are requested to insist on receipts for payment of fees for the whole session.
- Fines and other charges will be collected along with the monthly dues.
- In case a child loses the progress card, a duplicate card will be issued on payment of ₹ 20/- at the couter only after request has been made by the parents or guardians.
- If parents want to withdraw their wards from any standard other than Class-X they will get back their caution money after three years.
- Breakage of school or hostel property by the individual student will be subject to imposition of fine. Mass breakage of the same will be charged from the mass on the basis of equal share of the total cost.
- In case of long absence without intimation or nonpayment of tuition fee his/her name get struck off from the long Roll.
- School and Hostel fees are to be cleared by 30th of the same month or else fine of ₹ 60/- is charged from 1st of the following month.

FEE STRUCTURE

- There will be a reasonable enhancement over total fee structure every year.
- Mess dues is charged for the whole month if one has stayed for 10 days in the same month.
- Students not reporting on the re-opening day of the school after vacation will be charged ₹ 100/- for the very first day.
- Absence on any ground (other than medical ground supported by approved leave application) Will be charged ₹ 5/- per day.
- Long leave on medical ground is to be supported by Medical Certificate.
- Things once issued cannot be returned.

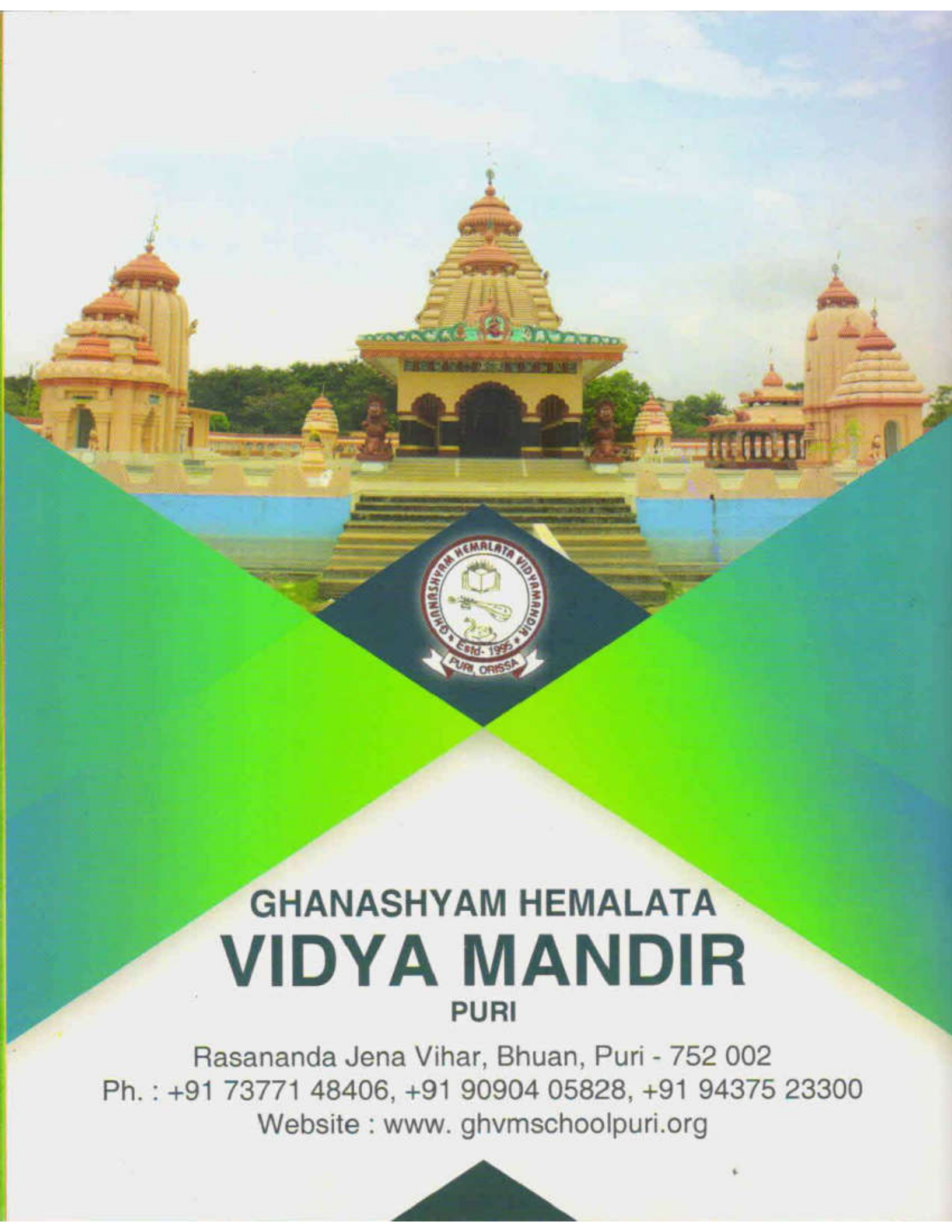
